


# IN 2022, WILL LOW-INCOME PEOPLE STILL BE INVISIBLE ?

Recent announcements of fare reductions for students, children and seniors show that with political will, it is quite possible for the STM to introduce a reduced transit fare for low-income people (a social fare)... This is urgently needed!

**For the right to mobility for all Montrealers !**

The more we find ourselves in poverty, the more difficult it is to access public transit and to get around. Being able to get to different places is essential: whether for meeting one's needs, looking for a job, going to the food bank, visiting relatives, going to medical appointments, etc.

Being limited in one's mobility contributes to the social exclusion and isolation of those who are low income.
